



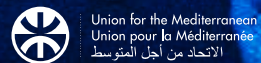

Founded to strengthen water issues in the international debate, the **One Water Committee** brings together institutions, businesses and universities, and civil society.

Active in key global forum, it is involved in preparing the **Union for the Mediterranean Ministerial meeting**, which will be held in **March 2026 in Rome**, for the signing of the new Mediterranean water declaration.

The One Water Committee is promoting the first **EuroMediterranean Water Forum** which will take place in **Rome from 29.9 to 2.10 2026**, co-organized with the Mediterranean Water Institute of Marseille (IME) and in partnership with the Union for the Mediterranean (UFM).

# EuroMediterranean Water Forum

A **unique event** that will address water issues in the Mediterranean area, the Balkans and in the European context but will launch bridges and contacts with Gulf countries as well as with African ones.

A **platform for dialogue** among policymakers, civil society, universities and businesses, accompanied by an exhibition showcasing technological and process innovations in the water sector.

**Working together to ensure water security in the Mediterranean by 2050.**

The forum is supported by Ministries of the Italian Government, with the technical partnership of CIHAEM Bari.



- **New actors beyond WEF E Nexus**  
New demands for water and emerging actors are increasing the sustainability challenges.  
While it's urgent to implement a 'source to sea' approach in the Mediterranean.
- **Access to Water**  
Distribution, value, and infrastructure to protect everyone's right to water.  
Blue Diplomacy and cooperation to face challenges together.
- **Blue Finance**  
Innovative financing, blue bonds, Debt-for-Water swaps, the evolving role of insurance and investment funds.
- **Water Quality**  
Protection and safety of water resources, water resilience, microplastics.  
The One Water/One Health approach.

- **Resource Optimization**  
Water use in agriculture, water balances, reuse and non-conventional water sources. Efficiency of networks and services. Protection of springs and aquifers.
- **Water Digitalization**  
New frontiers of technology and artificial intelligence serving the water sector.
- **Risk Prevention and Management**  
Adaptation to climate change and risk mitigation strategies.  
Resilience for coastal areas and urban centers.
- **Sustainable, Resilient and Equitable Blue Economy**  
Biodiversity, Green Maritime Transport and Smart Portsenergy, Desalination, Climate change, Pollution, Blue Tech.

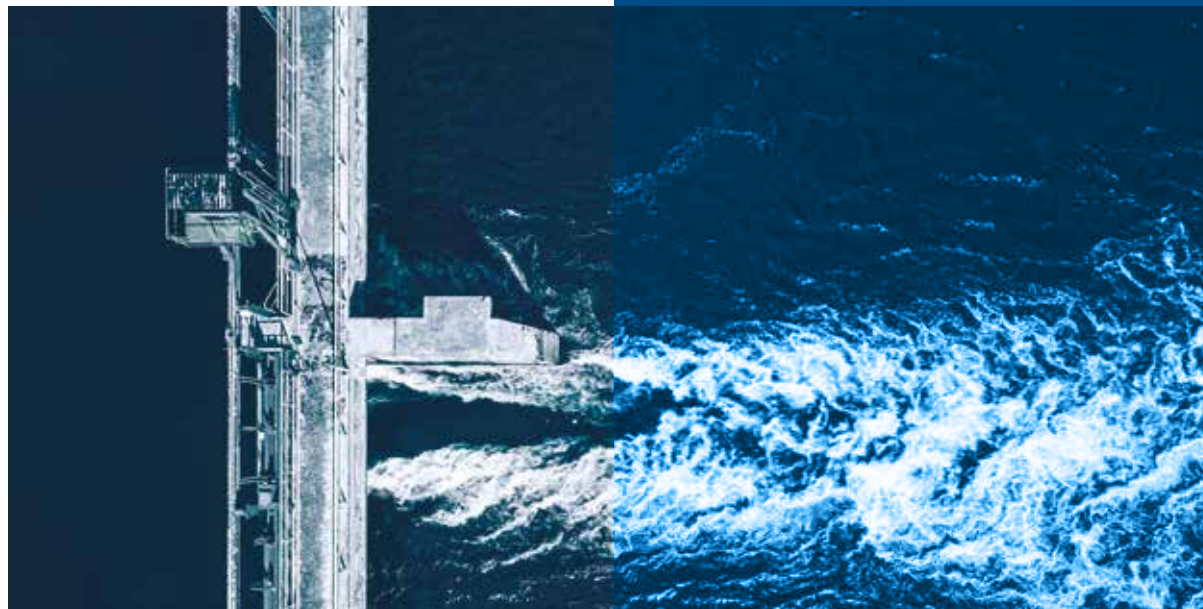
